Mad Squirrel Unity 3.8% ABV
Mad Squirrel Brewery, Hertfordshire. Est. 2004
This is a hazy blond beer with a purpose, dedicated to bringing you the freshest hop character, with plenty of citrus and stone fruit notes and a clean finish.
Hops: Amarillo, Centennial, Citra



Woodforde's Wherry 3.8% ABV
Woodforde's Brewery, Norfolk. Est. 1981
This amber ale has a sweet malt background, balanced by a fresh and zesty character from the crisp, floral flavours, resulting in a hoppy, bitter finish.
Hops: Challenger, Goldings, Savinjski Goldings



Hogs Back Surrey Nirvana 4.0% ABV
Hogs Back Brewery, Surrey. Est. 1992
This golden session IPA has an enticing hoppy aroma, leading to tropical fruit notes and a clean, dry finish, resulting in an easy-drinking, balanced character.
Hops: Cascade (UK), Centennial, Mosaic



Maxim Samson 4.0% ABV
Maxim Brewery, County Durham. Est. 2007
This chestnut beer delivers a smooth, creamy flavour, with fruity notes and hints of pear drop, leading to a refreshing bitterness on the back of the palate.
Hops: Goldings



Milestone Classic Dark Mild 4.0% ABV
Milestone Brewing, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2005
This black beer has a nutty, caramel and chocolate aroma, leading to rich, smooth and creamy roasted flavours, culminating in a subtle hoppiness in the finish.
Hops: Challenger, Perle, Progress



Nottingham Legend 4.0% ABV
Nottingham Brewery, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2000
This traditional amber-coloured best bitter has a rounded, well-balanced flavour, with biscuit notes on the palate and a long, pleasing, fruity finish.
Hops: Fuggles, Goldings



Saltaire Blonde 4.0% ABV
Saltaire Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2006
This straw-coloured ale has a creamy, biscuity malt base, balanced by a mild, spicy bitterness, resulting in a refreshing and easy-drinking character.
Hops: Magnum, Saaz



Stewart Copper Cascade 4.0% ABV
Stewart Brewing, Midlothian. Est. 2004
This copper ale has a velvety caramel malt backbone, complemented by zesty citrus notes and a subtle dried fruit sweetness, resulting in a balanced finish.
Hops: Challenger, Citra, Mosaic



Adnams Mosaic Pale Ale 4.1% ABV
Adnams Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1872
This golden ale has a hop-forward floral character, delivering assertive mango, peach, lemon, gooseberry and pine flavours, culminating in a dry, hoppy finish.
Hops: Mosaic



Hanlons Yellow Hammer 4.2% ABV
Hanlons Brewery, Devon. Est. 1996
This golden pale ale has a citrus hop aroma and is laden with bittersweet flavours, including fruit notes, leading to a refreshing, delicate, hoppy finish.
Hops: Admiral, Cascade, First Gold



Salcombe Shingle Bay 4.2% ABV
Salcombe Brewery, Devon. Est. 2016
This smooth, golden ale has citrus notes in its aroma and flavour, with hints of blackberry and spiced fruit adding complexity, before its crisp finish.
Hops: Chinook, First Gold, Goldings, Pacific Gem



Cairngorm Trade Winds 4.3% ABV
Cairngorm Brewery, Highlands. Est. 1997
This light golden beer is brewed with a high level of wheat, delivering a clean, fresh taste, balanced with fruit and citrus flavours and elderflower notes.
Hops: Perle



Oakham White Dwarf 4.3% ABV
Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993
This golden seasonal ale has a predominant English hop character, with a clean, refreshing and fruity flavour, culminating in a dry, zesty finish.
Hops: Cascade, Challenger, Goldings, Pioneer



Vale Red Kite 4.3% ABV
Vale Brewery, Buckinghamshire. Est. 1995
This chestnut beer is full of warm, toasted malt flavours, balanced by a subtle bitterness and floral spice notes, resulting in a rich, full-bodied character.
Hops: Brewer's Gold, Northdown



Coach House Innkeepers 4.5% ABV
Coach House Brewing, Cheshire. Est. 1991
This full-flavoured, ruby-coloured beer has a full, malty palate, balanced by a crisp hop flavour which gradually emerges through to the finish.
Hops: Admiral, First Gold, Pilgrim



Conwy Rampart 4.5% ABV
Conwy Brewery, Conwy. Est. 2003
This chestnut beer has an enticing floral hop aroma, leading to a smooth flavour, with spicy and citrus notes, hints of caramel and a sweet, malty finish.
Hops: Sovereign, WGV



JW Lees Gold 4.5% ABV
JW Lees Brewery, Manchester. Est. 1828
This golden ale has a citrus and tropical fruit aroma, leading to a balance of malt and hop flavours, together with an easy-drinking, refreshing character.
Hops: Admiral, Cascade (UK), Jester



Otter Ale 4.5% ABV
Otter Brewery, Devon. Est. 1990
This mahogany best bitter has a malty aroma, with hints of fruit continuing into its full-bodied flavour, balanced by a bittersweet character and a dry finish.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles, Pilgrim



Theakston XB 4.5% ABV
Theakston Brewery, North Yorkshire. Est. 1827
This classic ruby beer has a rich, inviting aroma leading to a blend of generous fruit flavours and underlying malt notes in its balanced, full-bodied flavour.
Hops: Bramling Cross, Challenger, Fuggles, Progress, Target



Elgood's Golden Newt 4.6% ABV
Elgood's Brewery, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1795
This golden beer has an inviting floral aroma, leading to spicy hop, peach and apricot notes, balanced by a subtle sweetness, before the long, bitter finish.
Hops: Cascade, Fuggles, Goldings



Orkney Dark Island 4.6% ABV
Orkney Brewery, Orkney. Est. 1988
This iconic, award-winning dark ale has a ripe, fruity, roast coffee nose, leading to flavours of dark chocolate, dried fruit, dates and nuts.
Hops: East Kent Goldings, First Gold



Redemption Urban Dusk 4.6% ABV
Redemption Brewing, London. Est. 2010
This chestnut-coloured beer has an inviting coffee aroma, leading to caramel, hazelnut and dark fruit flavours, balanced by citrus notes in the finish.
Hops: Bramling Cross



Batemans XXXB 4.8% ABV
Batemans Brewery, Lincolnshire. Est. 1874
This tawny ale has a pleasing peppery and malt aroma, while its blend of malt and hops imparts spicy notes and a balance of fruit and biscuit in the flavour.
Hops: Bobek, Challenger, Goldings



Frome Gulp IPA 4.8% ABV
Frome Brewing, Somerset. Est. 1999
This deep golden beer has peach and grapefruit aromas leading to citrus fruit and a juicy bittersweet flavour, resulting in a bracing, dry and bitter finish.
Hops: Admiral, Amarillo



Leeds Midnight Bell 4.8% ABV
Kirkstall Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2011
This deep ruby premium dark mild has a full-bodied and complex character, with the predominant malt flavour and hints of chocolate balanced by subtle hop notes.
Hops: Goldings, Willamette



Stonehenge Great Bustard 4.8% ABV
Stonehenge Ales, Wiltshire. Est. 1984
This deep amber beer has a full-bodied character – a complex blend of rich fruit, toffee and caramel malt flavours, balanced by spicy and citrusy notes.
Hops: Cascade, Pilgrim



Sambrook's Powerhouse Porter 4.9% ABV
Sambrook's Brewery, London. Est. 2008
This ruby porter has aromas of toasted malt and winter fruits, leading to a rich dark chocolate flavour, with hints of caramel, coffee and liquorice.
Hops: Boadicea, Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings



Brewster's Rutterkin 5.0% ABV
Brewster's Brewery, Leicestershire. Est. 1998
This golden-coloured ale has grapefruit and lemon aromas, complemented by a light malt sweetness, leading to citrus notes and a refreshing, zesty finish.
Hops: Cascade, Chinook



Little Valley Tod's Blonde 5.0% ABV
Great Newsome Brewery, East Yorkshire. Est. 2007
This straw-coloured beer has notes of malt and fruity hops in its aroma, leading to a crisp, refreshing flavour, balanced by a smooth bitterness in the finish.
Hops: Brewer's Gold, Tradition



Pheasantry Dancing Dragonfly 5.0% ABV
Pheasantry Brewery, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2012
This pale golden IPA delivers a fruity aroma and a flavour packed full of peach and exotic fruit notes, resulting in a very drinkable, refreshing character.
Hops: Cascade, Galaxy, Raku, Summit



Portobello American Pale Ale 5.0% ABV
Portobello Brewery, London. Est. 2012
This pale golden beer has a hoppy aroma, generous fruity notes and balanced bitterness, resulting in a clean, crisp character.
Hops: Amarillo, Citra, Summit



Reedley Hallows Nook of Pendle 5.0% ABV
Reedley Hallows Brewing, Lancashire. Est. 2012
This amber ale has an inviting malty aroma, leading to a warming character of dried tropical fruit flavours, balanced by subtle hops and emerging malt notes.
Hops: Cascade, Citra, Fuggles



Rooster's Fort Smith 5.0% ABV
Rooster's Brewing, North Yorkshire. Est. 1993
This pale golden APA is big and bold in character, with tropical and passion fruit aromas leading to generous hop and fruity flavours and a bitter finish.
Hops: Chinook, Citra



Rudgate Valkyrie APA 5.0% ABV
Rudgate Brewery, North Yorkshire. Est. 1992
This golden beer, brewed in the style of an American west coast pale ale, has subtle tropical fruit notes in its aroma and flavour, plus a full, hoppy finish.
Hops: Cascade, Chinook, Rakau



Bays Devon Dumpling 5.1% ABV
Bays Brewery, Devon. Est. 2007
This golden ale has a fresh hop character throughout, delivering an inviting aroma and full flavour, with its balanced sweetness providing a smooth character.
Hops: Northern Brewer, Sovereign



Exeter Darkness 5.1% ABV
Exeter Brewery, Devon. Est. 2003
This black stout has aromas and flavours of roasted coffee beans, chocolate and liquorice, resulting in a luxurious, smoky character and a silky-smooth finish.
Hops: Goldings



Peerless Knee-Buckler IPA 5.2% ABV
Peerless Brewing, Merseyside. Est. 2009
This golden IPA delivers a hoppy aroma, leading to a perfect balance of zesty hop bitterness and biscuit malt notes, resulting in a distinctive, fruity finish.
Hops: Cascade, Citra, Columbus, Summit



Daleside Monkey Wrench 5.3% ABV
Daleside Brewery, North Yorkshire. Est. 1992
This ruby-coloured strong ale has fruit and malt aromas, leading to a rich, malty backbone in the flavour, with some fruit notes, and a hoppy and sweet finish.
Hops: Goldings, Northern Brewer



Mauldons Black Adder 5.3% ABV
Mauldons Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1982
This award-winning strong, dark, bitter stout has roast and nut aromas, a fruity balance of hops and dark malt, plus an excellent, lingering finish.
Hops: Fuggles



Phoenix Wobbly Bob 6.0% ABV
Phoenix Brewery, Manchester. Est. 1982
This amber strong ale has a subtle spice aroma, leading to subtle hop notes and a strong malt and fruit balance, resulting in a moreish sweetness in the finish.
Hops: Brewer's Gold



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
